Homeowners are requested to offer their homes for a minimum of four nights during the program dates (specified below) and should include their usual services when renting their home. If the owner wishes, Punta Mita's marketing team agrees to promote your home with a personalized plan according to the nights offered to the cause in publicity for the rental of your property throughout the year.

Through "Mi CASA, TU CAUSA," Punta Mita homeowners are once again demonstrating their commitment to supporting the local Punta de Mita community and making a positive impact in the world.
